## ARCHITECTURE SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

AIA Northern Nevada, a chapter of the American Institute of Architects, is pleased to announce a call for applications for the **2011 Raymond Hellmann Memorial Scholarship**. The scholarship is named for noted northern Nevada architect Raymond Hellmann, AIA, and consists of a monetary award to a student (or students) meeting the following criteria:

- ◆ Must be a resident of Churchill, Douglas, Elko, Eureka, Humboldt, Lander, Lyon, Mineral, Pershing, Storey, Washoe, or White Pine counties or Carson City, Nevada,
- ◆ Must be a high school senior accepted to an NAAB accredited school of Architecture or Truckee Meadows Community College (TMCC), or currently enrolled in the TMCC Architectural Design program.
- ◆ Demonstrate proficiency and/or need on the application form.

Funds for this endowment have come from friends and family of Raymond Hellmann, AIA and the AIA Northern Nevada members, allied professionals, individuals interested in the architecture profession for the purpose of recognizing scholastic achievement, demonstrated talent and potential for success in the profession. Financial need and special needs students are also taken into consideration.

The information provided on your application, together with your letters of recommendation and transcripts will be treated confidentially and used to evaluate your degree of scholastic promise, level of achievement, degree of need and other aspects of your eligibility. The 2011 Hellmann scholarship(s) will be determined by the AIA Northern Nevada scholarship committee and **announced in April 2011**. The award may be a single scholarship or multiple scholarships.
